The data was collected manually through a sheet that was filled by each entity, gets revised and consolidated to generate the MBRGI Annual report book, which is also published online on the MBRGI website. Manual data processing is error prone, unsecured and unformed.

Solution:

Our domain experts had cooperated with MBRGI team in order to create a brand-new system that automates the whole life cycle of annual achievements starting with defining pillars, setting goals, initiating cycle going through data collection, data review and ending with a 360-degree view of all annual achievements.
